1. Parties

Uttar Pradesh Rajarshi Tandon Open University, Shantipuram, Sector-F, Phaphamau, Prayagraj, (U.P.)-211021, established in 1998 (here after called "UPRTOU" which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context in which it is used, includes its successor and administration) being of the FIRST PARTY;

And

U.P. Madhyamik Shiksha Parishad, Prayagraj "UPMSP" which expression shall unless repugnant to the context in which it is used, includes its successor, executor, administration and assignee) of the SECOND PARTY. UPRTOU and UPMSP individually referred to herein as a 'party' and collectively as the 'Parties'

2. Purpose

- 2.1 The purpose of this MEMORENDUM OF UNDERSTANDING is to promote mutual Co-operation, scholarly collaboration, cultural interaction and friendship by supporting educational, professional activities among faculty and students of the two establishments. Accordingly, the areas of cooperation will include, subject to mutual consent, any programme offered at their university as felt desirable and feasible on either side and that both sides will contribute to the fostering and development of the cooperative relationship between the two establishments.
- 2.2 Specific areas of cooperation between the two establishments, subject to the availability of funds and the approval of UPMSP and UPRTOU, include, but not limited to the following:
- (a) Adoption, adaption, and exchange of academic programmes in the broad areas of mutual interest and related disciplines focusing on the blended and digital learning process.
 - (b) R&D collaborations in the academic and ODL areas.
 - (c) Detailed information of 10+2 (Intermediate) students shall be shared with UPRTOU so that information regarding new subjects, new programmes, career advancement, admission motivation programmes etc. can be conveyed to the students through E-mail, SMS etc. so that the students can benefit from it.
 - (d) Mutual coordination of teacher/principal with the teachers of the University to participate in meetings, workshops, symposia, seminars etc.
 - (e) Consideration should be given to making aided intermediate colleges and government intermediate colleges examination centres.
 - (f) UPRTOU's infrastructure facilities may be considered for use in 10+2 examination work.
 - (g) Sharing of best practices in the field of programme design, development and delivery.
 - (h) Promotion of Skill Development Programmes to boost employment opportunities for our learners, particularly the under-privileged groups
 - (i) Joint collaboration for Faculty Development Programme that will include classroom seminars and site visits which may include trips to Learner Support Centres, Regional Centres, historical places, museums, educational institutions, Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs), villages, etc.
 - (j) All other relevant activities of mutual interest to UPRTOU and UPMSP



- 2.3 A Memorandum of Understanding (MOU's) shall be developed for specific agreements based on the mutually agreed upon objectives and outcomes, at any time, but require the signatures of appropriate authorities (or expressly designated delegates).
- 2.4 The purpose of this MEMORENDUM OF UNDERSTANDING is to outline an academic and management framework between the two parties, designed to promote internationalization at both institutions. The parties do not intend to be legally bound to each other, and this MEMORENDUM OF UNDERSTANDING does not impose legal obligations on either party.

3. Mode of Operation

- 3.1 Both parties will provide necessary support for effective implementation of the MoU within their organisational rules and procedures.
- 3.2 This MoU shall be effective from the date it is signed by both the Parties.
- 3.3 Within the broad framework of the MoU, UPMSP and UPRTOU can develop joint research, academic or scientific programmes, exchanges, development of facilities, etc.
- 3.4 Any financial commitment for joint activities under this MoU shall be subject to the approval by the competent authority of the respective organizations.
- 3.5 The school of vocational studies, UPRTOU or any other school of UPRTOU and appropriate authority at UPMSP will also formulate the procedure for exchange of students, faculty and other visitors, in accordance with the University norms. The travel and stay of the faculty under MoU will be supported by the respective university/ establishment as per their norms.

4. Notices

- 4.1 Every notice, request or any other communication required or permitted to be given pursuant to this MEMORENDUM OF UNDERSTANDING shall be in writing and delivered personally or sent by registered or certified post or via courier or facsimile or by e-mail (which shall be acknowledged by the other Party) to the Parties at their address and facsimile number.

5. Publicity and Advertising

5.1 The parties agree that each may publish or advertise the existence and nature of activity under this MEMORENDUM OF UNDERSTANDING. Nothing in this agreement shall be construed as confidential.

6. Financial Provisions



6.1 No financial commitment from either Organization shall be assumed unless a formal approval/acceptance to that effect has been accorded through signed documents by both the Organizations.

7. Confidentiality

7.1 During the term of this MoU and after the termination of this MoU, each party will treat all information exchanged by the Parties or its employees as confidential. All information will be treated as the property of the disclosing party and will be returned to it immediately upon request.

8. Duration of MoU

8.1 This MEMORENDUM OF UNDERSTANDING will be effective for a period of five years, at which time it will be reviewed for possible renewal for another three-year period.



8.2 Either party may, with sixty days written notice, terminate the MEMORENDUM OF UNDERSTANDING in advance of its normal expiration or request the renegotiation of its conditions.

9. Terms and Conditions

9.1 Nothing contained in this agreement is intended, nor shall it be constructed as creating a partnership or joint venture between the parties, nor as creating or requiring any ongoing or continuing relationship or commitment between UPRTOU and UPMSP beyond the relationship specially created by this MoU. Unless specifically provided herein, no party or representative shall be deemed a representative, agent or employee of any other party by contract, by employment or for any purpose whatsoever.

9.2 UPRTOU and UPMSP agree to help identify and invite faculty members and researchers from other institutes to participate in Conferences, Workshops and Short-term courses.

9.3 This MoU may be amended, renewed and terminated by mutual written agreement of the Parties at any time.

9.4 Any dispute or difference arisen out of this MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING shall be resolved through amicable settlement.

9.5 Each party shall co-indemnify and hold each party harmless for any and all costs or expenses associated with damages or claims arising out of activities commenced under this MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING, or any act or omission of the party, its employees or others acting on its behalf while undertaking any aspect of these cooperative activities.

9.6 This MEMORENDUM OF UNDERSTANDING is in two originals, and both parties shall hold one original copy.

10. Miscellaneous

10.1 This MoU constitutes the entire agreement between the Parties hereto concerning the subject matter hereof and supersedes and replaces any prior agreements, communications, representations and understandings between the Parties, whether oral or written.

10.2 Each party acknowledges that the resources of each party will limit the extent of the intended cooperative activities, and the parties agree to work together to identify and obtain appropriate third-party support for any cooperative activities
