

department or unit of the University that he may consider necessary for the performance of his duties;

(o) to arrange for the conduct of continuous internal audit of the accounts of the University, and shall pre-audit such bill as may be required in accordance with any standing orders in that behalf.

(p) to perform such other functions in respect of financial matters as may be assigned to him by the Executive Council or the Vice-Chancellor;

(q) to exercise disciplinary control over all the employees in the Audit and Account Section of the University below the rank of the Assistant Registrar (Accounts) and shall supervise the work of the Deputy Registrar, Assistant Registrar (Accounts) and the Accounts Officer.

4.20 If any difference of opinion arises between the Vice-Chancellor and the Finance Officer on any matter concerning the performance of the functions of the Finance Officer, the question shall be referred to the State Government whose decision shall be final and binding.

4.21 the Examination Controller shall be whole time officer of the University and shall be appointed by the State Government on the recommendation of the Executive Council of the University. The person recommended by the University for the appointment of Examination Controller shall not be below the rank of the Reader of a University.

4.22 The emoluments of the Examination Controller shall be such as may be determined from time to time by the State Government.

4.23 Other conditions of service of the Examination Controller shall be governed by the service conditions prescribed by these statutes for the teachers of the University.

4.24 The examination Controller shall be responsible for the due custody of the records pertaining to his work. He shall be ex-officio Secretary of the Examinations Committee of the University and shall be bound to place before such committee all such information as may be necessary for

transaction of its business. He shall also perform such other duties as may be prescribed by the Ordinances or required, from time to time by the Executive Council or the Vice-Chancellor. He shall not, by virtue of this statute be entitled to vote. He may require any information from any office or school of studies or study centre or the University, the production of such return or the furnishing of such information as may be necessary for the discharge of his duties.

4.25 The Examination controller shall have administrative control over the employees working under him.

4.26 Subject to the superintendence of the Vice-Chancellor and Examinations Committee, the Examination Controller shall conduct the Examinations and make all other arrangements therefore and be responsible for the due execution of all processes connected therewith.

4.27 The Examination Controller shall not be offered nor shall he accept any remuneration for any work in the University, except in accordance with the order of the State Government.

5.32 The Finance Committee shall consist of :-

(a) the Vice-Chancellor-Chairman

(b) the Secretary to the State Government in the Department of Higher Education or his nominee not below the rank of Special Secretary-Member

(c) the Secretary to the State Government in the Finance Department or his nominee not below the rank of Special Secretary-Member

(d) the Prov-Vice-Chancellor-Member

(e) the Registrar-Member

(f) Examination Controller-Member

(g) one person, who is not an employee of the University nominated by Executive Council-Member

(h) the Finance Officer-Member-Secretary.

5.33 the Term of the members of the Finance Committee shall be two years.

5.34. The Finance Committee shall administration advise the Executive Council on matters relating to the administration of property and funds of the University. It shall, having regard to the income and resources of the University, fix limits for the total recurring and non-recurring expenditure for the ensuing financial year and may for any special reasons, revise during the financial year of the limits of expenditure so fixed and the limits so fixed shall be binding on the Executive Council.

5.35 Unless the proposal having financial implication has been recommended by the Finance Committee, the Executive

Council shall not take a decision thereon, and if the Executive Council disagrees with the recommendation of the Finance Committee, it shall refer the proposal back to the Finance Committee with reasons for its disagreement and if the Executive Council again disagrees with the recommendation of the Finance Committee the matter shall be referred to the Chancellor whose decision thereon shall be final.

5.36 If Executive Council at any time after the consideration of the annual financial estimates (i.e., the budget) proposes any revision thereof involving recurring or non-recurring expenditure, the Executive Council shall refer the proposal to the Finance Committee.

5.37 The annual accounts and the financial estimates of the University prepared by the Finance Officer shall be laid before the Finance Committee for consideration and thereafter submit to the Executive Council for approval.

5.38 Members of the Finance Committee shall have the right to record a minute of dissent, if they do not agree with any decision of the Finance Committee.

5.39 The Finance Committee shall meet at least twice every year to examine the accounts and to scrutinise proposals for expenditure.

5.40 The Examination Committee shall consist of following :-

- (i) the Vice-Chancellor-Chairman;
- (ii) the Pro-Vice-Chancellor-Member;
- (iii) all director of schools of studies-Member;
- (iv) one member of the Executive Council nominated by it-Member;
- (v) one member of Academic Council-Member;
- (vi) two members of Executive Council nominated by Vice-Chancellor-Member;
- (vii) Examination Controller-Secretary;

5.41 The terms of the members of Examination Committee shall be one year.

5.42 The meetings of the Examination Committee shall be convened by the Vice-Chancellor as and when necessary.

5.43 The Examination Committee shall supervise all examinations of the University, including moderation and tabulation, and perform the following other functions, namely :-

- (a) to appoint examiners and moderators on the recommendation of the Board of Studies and, if necessary, to remove them;
- (b) to review from time to time the results of University examinations and to submit the same to the Academic Council for approval;
- (c) to declare the result of the University after the approval of Academic Council;
- (d) to make recommendation to the Academic Council for the improvement of the examination system.

5.44 The Examinations Committee may appoint such number of sub-committees as it thinks fit to deal with and decide cases relating to the use of unfair means by the examinees.

5.45 Notwithstanding anything contained in the Statutes, the Examinations Committee or sub-committee to whom the Examinations Committee has authorised its power in this behalf under Statute 5.44 shall have power to debar an examinee from future examinations of the University.

#### **B. Other Authorities**

5.46 It is hereby declared that the following shall be the other Authorities of the University :-

5.47 There shall be a Board of Studies in each subject, and the constitution, powers and functions of which are given below :-

- (1) The Board of Studies shall consist of,-
  - (a) all Professors of the School of Studies;
  - (b) two Readers by rotation and seniority for one year;
