CHAPTER – V
Authorities of the University

18. The following shall be authorities of the University— Authorities of the University
- (a) The Executive Council;
 - (b) The Academic Council;
 - (c) The Planning Board;
 - (d) The Board of Recognition;
 - (e) The Schools of studies;
 - (f) The Finance Committee;
 - (g) The Examination Committee; and
 - (h) Such other authorities as may be declared by the Statutes to be authorities of the University.
19. (1) The Executive Council shall be the principal executive body of the University. The Executive Council
- (2) The constitution of the Executive Council, the term of office of its members and its powers and functions shall be such as may be prescribed.
20. (1) The Academic Council shall be the principal academic body of the University and shall, subject to the provisions of this Act, the Statutes and Ordinances, have the control and general regulation of, and be responsible for the maintenance of standard of learning, education, instruction, evaluation and examination within the university and shall exercise such other powers and perform such other function as may be prescribed.
- (2) The constitution of the Academic Council and the term of office of its members shall be such as may be prescribed.
21. (1) There shall be constituted a Planning Board of the University which shall be the principal body of the University and shall also be responsible for the The Planning Board

- monitoring of the developments of the University on the lines indicated in the objects of the University.
- (2) The Constitution of the Planning Board, the term of office of its members and its powers and functions shall be as may be prescribed.
22. (1) The Board of Recognition shall be responsible for admitting Colleges and other institutions to the privileges of the University. The Board of Recognition
- (2) The Constitution and the other powers and functions of the Board of Recognition shall be such as may be prescribed.
23. (1) There shall be such number of Schools of Studies as the University may determine from time to time. The Schools of Studies
- (2) The Constitution, powers and functions of the Schools of Studies shall be such as may be prescribed.
24. The Constitution, powers and functions of the Finance Committee shall be such as may be prescribed. The Finance Committee
25. The Constitution, powers and functions of the other authorities which may be declared by the Statutes to be authorities of the University shall be such as may be prescribed. Other Authorities

CHAPTER – VI

(Statutes, Ordinances and Regulations)

26. Subject to the provisions of this Act, the Statutes may provide for any matter relating to the University and shall in particular provide for :- Statutes
- (a) the manner for appointment of Vice-Chancellor, the term of his appointment, the emoluments and other conditions of his service and the powers and functions that may be exercised and performed by him;
- (b) the manner of appointment of Pro-Vice-Chancellor, Directors, Registrar, Examination Controller, the Finance Officer and other officers, the emoluments and other conditions of their service and the powers
