Process to be followed to ensure accountability and Transparency in purchase:

Non recurring:

Purchase: First of all demand is put up by head of the school pertaining to certain purchase which enclose estimated cost of equipment to be purchased along with possible suppliers. The other details like immediate requirement or time limits for supply are also specified. Then demand is approved by committee in form of sanction letter which is endorsed by Registrar. This is followed by call for quotations from different vendors (As per Government Norms) and afterobtaining quotations a comparative chart is drawn. Then, purchase order is sent to vendor which meet conditions for supply along with minimum cost. On receipt of equipment stock and gate entry is made by receiving department and end user certificate is issued which pertain that enduser is satisfied with functioning. All purchase process will be based on as per govt. guidelines.

Recurring:

The requirement of conducting certain activities like extension lectures, workshops, training, hiring, consumable etc. is discussed in concerned schools with the helpof CIQA or advisory committee, if this falls under specific grant. Then expenditures done on above stated heads as per need. Then complete expenditure is discussed in next meeting along with details of activities performed. Sample Documents are given below:-

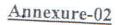
