In pursuance of the provisions of clause (3) of Article 348 of the Constitution, the Governor is pleased to order the publication of the following English translation of the Uttar Pradesh Rajarshi Tandon Mukta Vishwavidyalaya Adhiniayam 1999. (Uttar Pradesh Adhiniyam Sankhya 10 of 1999) as passed by the Uttar Pradesh Legislature and assented to by the Governor on March 24, 1999.

THE UTTAR PRADESH RAJARSHI TANDON OPEN UNIVERSITY ACT, 1999

(U.P.ACT No. 10 OF 1999)

[As passed by the Uttar Pradesh Legislature]

AN

ACT

to provide for the establishment of an Open University in Uttar Pradesh for the introduction and promotion of distance education systems and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto.

It is hereby enacted in the Fiftieth Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

CHAPTER - I Preliminary

- (1) This Act may be called the Uttar Pradesh Short title and RAJARSHI TANDON Open University Act, commencement 1999
 - (2) It shall come into force on such date as the State Government may, by notification, appoint in this behalf.
- 2. In this Act:-

Definitions

(a) "Academic Council" and "Executive Council" means respectively and Academic Council, and the Executive Council of the University:

- (e) "Finance Committee" means the Finance Committee of the University;
- (f) "other backward classes" means the backward classes or citizens specified in Schedule I of the Uttar Pradesh Public Services (Reservation for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other Backward Classes) Act, 1994, as amended from time to time;
- (g) "Planning Board" means the Planning Board of the University;
- (h) "prescribed" means prescribed by the Statutes;
- (i) "school" means a schools of studies of the University;
- (j) "Statutes", "Ordinances" and "Regulations" means, respectively, the Statutes, Ordinances and Regulations of the University;
- (k) "student" means a student of the University, and includes any person who has enrolled

- "teacher" means a person employed for (m)imparting instruction in the University for giving guidance or rendering assistance to students for pursuing any course of study of the University and includes a Principal or Director of a College;
- "University" means the Uttar Pradesh (n)Rajarshi Tandon Open University established under Section 3.

CHAPTER - II

The University and its Objects

There shall be established a University by Establishment (1)the name of the Uttar Pradesh Rajarshi and incoopera-Tandon Open University.

- The headquarters of the University shall be (2)at Allahabad and it may establish or maintain colleges or study centre at such other places in the State as it may deem fit.
- The Chancellor, Vice-Chancellor and the (3)members of the Executive Council and the Academic Council for the time being holding office as such in the University, shall constitute a body corporate by the name of the Uttar Pradesh Rajarshi Tandon Open

- The University shall promote dissemination The Objects of of learning and knowledge through distance the University education systems to a large segment of the population and shall, in organizing its activities, have due regard to the objects specified in the schedule.
- The University shall have the following Powers of the powers, namely:-
 - (i) to provide for instruction in such branches of knowledge, technology, vocations and professions as the University may determine from time to time and to make provision for research;
 - (ii) to plan and prescribe courses of study for degrees, diplomas, certificates or for any other purpose;
 - (iii) to hold examinations and confer degrees, diplomas, certificates or other academic distinctions or recognitions on person who have pursued a course of study or conducted research in the manner laid down by the Statutes and Ordinance;
 - (iv) to confer honorary degrees or other distinctions in the manner prescribed;
 - (v) to determine the manner in which distance education in relation to the academic programmes of the University may be organized;
 - (vi) to institute professorships, readerships, lecturerships and other academic positions necessary for imparting instructions or for preparing educational material or for conducting other academic activities,

including guidance, designing and delivery of course and evaluation of the work done by the students; and to appoint persons to such professorships, readerships, lecturerships and other academic positions.

- (vii) to co-operate with, and seek the cooperation of other universities and
 institution of higher learning, professional
 bodies and organisa-tions for such purposes
 as the University considers necessary;
- (viii) to institute and award fellowships, scholarships, prizes and such other awards for recognition of merit as the University may deem fit.
- (ix) to establish and maintain such regional centres as may be determined by the University from time to time;
- (x) to establish, maintain or recognize Study Centre in the manner prescribed;
- (xi) to provide or the preparation of instructional material, including films, cassettes, tapes, video cassettes and other softwares;
- (xii) to organize the conduct refresher courses, workshop, seminars and other programmes for teachers, lessonwriters, evaluators and other academic staff;
- (xiii) to recognize examinations of or periods of stud, whether in full or part, at other universities, institutions or other places of higher learning as equivalent to examination or periods of study in the University, and to withdraw such recognition at any time;

(xiv) To make provisions for research and

- (xv) to create administrative, ministerial and necessary posts and to make appointments thereto;
- (xvi) to receive benefactions donations and gifts and to acquire, hold, maintain and dispose of any property movable or immovable including trust and Government property, for the purposes of the University;
- (xvii) to borrow, with the approval of the State Government, whether on the security of the property of the University or otherwise, money for the purposes of University;
- (xviii) to enter into, carry out, vary or cancel contracts;
- (xix) to demand and receive such fees and other charges as may be laid down by the ordinances;
- to provide control and maintain discipline among the students and all categories of employees and to lay down the conditions of services of such employees, including their codes of conduct;
- (xxi) to recognize any institution of higher learning or studies for such purposes as the University may determine and to withdraw such recognition;
- Visiting Professors, Emeritus Professors consultants, fellows, scholars, artists, course writers and such other persons who may contribute to the advancement of the objects of the University.

- to make arrangements for the promotion of (XXV) the general health and welfare of the employees;
- to confer autonomous status on a college or (xxvi) a regional centre in the manner prescribed;
- to admit to its privileges any college in the (xxvii) State subject to such conditions as may be prescribed; provided that no college shall be so admitted

except with the prior approval of the Chancellor;

- (xxviii) to do all such acts as may be necessary or incidental to the exercise of all or any of the powers of the University as are necessary and conducive to the promotion of all or any of the Objects of the University;
- Notwithstanding anything contained in any Territorail 6. other law for the time being in force, the exercise of University shall in the exercise of its powers powers have jurisdiction over the whole of Uttar Pradesh.

The University shall be open to persons of either sex irrespective of class or creed, and it shall not be lawful for the University to

adopt or impose on any person any test whatsoever of religious belief or profession in order to entitle him to be appointed as a teacher of the University, or to hold any other office therein or admitted as a student in the University or to graduate there at, or to enjoy or exercise any privilege thereof.

Nothing in sub-section (1) shall be deemed to prevent the University from making any special provision for the appointment or admission of women or of persons belonging or admission of women or of persons belonging to the Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes or other backward classes.

CHAPTER - III

Inspection and Inquiry

The State Government shall have the right to Visitation 8. cause an inspection to be made, by such person or persons as it may direct, of the University or any college or study centre maintained by the University including its buildings, libraries, laboratories, workshops equipments and also of the and examinations, teaching and other work conducted or done by the University or such college or study centre or to cause an inquiry to be made in the like manner in respect of connected with the matter any administration and finances of the University or such college or such centre.

Where the State Government decides to cause an inspection or inquiry to be made under sub section (I), it shall inform the University of the same through the Registrar, and any person nominated by the Executive Council may be present at such inspection or inquiry as representative of the University and he shall have the right to be heard as such;

Provided that no legal practitioner shall appear, plead or act on behalf of the University at such inspection or inquiry.

- (7) The State Government shall send to the Chancellor a copy of every report of an inspection or inquiry caused to be made under sub section (1) and of every communication received from the Vice-Chancellor under sub-section (5) and of every direction issued under sub section (6) and also of every report or information received in respect of compliance or non compliance with such direction.
- (8) Without prejudice to the provisions to subsection (6), if the Chancellor on consideration of any document or material referred, to in subsection (7) is of opinion that the Executive Council has failed to carry out its functions or has abused its powers, he may, after giving it an opportunity of submitting a written explanation, order that in supersession of the said Executive Council, an ad-hoc Executive Council, consisting of the Vice-Chancellor and such other persons not exceeding ten in number as the chancellor may appoint in that behalf

- (iii) It shall be the duty of the Vice-Chancellor to furnish such information or records relating to the administration of the affairs of the University as the Chancellor may call for;
- (iv) The Chancellor shall have such other powers as may be conferred on him by or under this Act or the statutes.
- 11. (1) The Vice-Chancellor shall be a whole time The Vice-salaried officer of the University and shall be Chancellor appointed by the Chancellor in such manner, for such terms and on such emoluments and other conditions of service as may be prescribed;
 - (2) The Vice-Chancellor shall be the principal academic and executive officer of the University, and shall exercise supervision and control over the affairs of the University and give effect to other decisions of all the authorities of the University.
 - (3) The Vice-Chancellor, may if he is of the opinion that immediate action is necessary on any matter, exercise any power conferred on any officer or authority of the University by or under this Act and shall report to such officer or authority the action taken by him on such matter.

Provided that if the officer or authority concerned is of the opinion that such action ought not to have been taken, it may refer the matter to the Chancellor whose decision thereon shall be final;

The Vice-Chancellor, if he is of the opinion (4)that any decision of any authority is beyond the powers of the authority conferred by the provisions of this Act Statutes or Ordinances or that any decision taken is not in the interests of the University may ask the authority concerned to review its decision within sixty days of such decision and if the authority refuses to review its decision either in whole or in part or no decision is taken by it within the said period of sixty days, the matter shall be referred to the Chancellor whose decision thereon shall be final;

> Provided that the decision of the authority concerned shall remained suspended during the period of review of such decision by the authority or the Chancellor as the case may be, under this sub-section.

CHAPTER -VI (Statutes, Ordinances and Regulations)

- Subject to the provisions of this Acts, the Statutes Statutes may provide for any matter relating to the University and shall in particular provide for:—
 - (a) the manner for appointment of Vice-Chancellor, the term of his appointment, the emoluments and other conditions of his service and powers and functions that may be exercised and performed by him;
 - (b) the manner of appointment of Pro-Vice-Chancellor, Directors, Registrar, Examination Controller, the Finance Officer and other officers, the emoluments and other conditions of their service and the powers and function that may be exercised and performed by each of such officer;
 - (c) the constitution of Executive Council and other authorities of the University, the terms of office of the members of such authorities and the powers and functions that may be exercised and performed by such authorities;
 - (d) the appointment of teachers and other employees of the University, their emoluments and other conditions of service;

- (e) the constitution of a pension or provident fund and the establishment of an insurance scheme for the benefit of the employees of the University;
- (f) the principles governing the seniority of service of the teachers and other employees of the University;
- the procedure in relation to any appeal or application for review by any teacher, employee or student of the University against the action of any officer or authority of the University, including the time within which such appeal or application for review shall be preferred or made;
- (h) the procedure for the settlement of disputes between the teachers, employees or students of the University, and the University;
- (i) the allocation and disbursement of grants to colleges and other institutions.
- (j) the conditions that are required to be fulfilled for admission of the colleges to the privileges of the University;
- (k) all other matters which by this Act are to be, or may be, provided for by the Statutes.
- 27. (1) The first statutes of the University shall be Statutes how made by the State Government by made notification.
 - (2) The Executive Council may from time to time, make new or additional Statutes or may amend or repeal the statutes referred to in sub section (1);

- (3) Every new Statute or addition to a statute or any amendment or repeal of statute shall be submitted to the Chancellor, who may assent to it or withhold his assent thereon or remit it to the Executive Council for further consideration.
- (4) A new Statute or a statute amending or repealing an existing statute shall not be valid unless it has been assented to by the Chancellor.
- (5) Notwithstanding anything contained in the foregoing sub-sections, the Chancellor may make new or additional Statutes or amend or repeal the Statutes referred to in sub-section (1) during the period of three years from the commencement of this Act.
- (6) Notwithstanding anything contained in the foregoing sub sections the State Government may direct the Executive Council to make provision in the Statutes in respect of any matter specified by it, and if the Executive Council is unable to implement such a direction within sixty days of its receipt, the State Government may, with the assent of the Chancellor, after considering the reasons, if any communicated by the Executive Council for its inability to comply with such direction, make or amend the Statutes

- 28. (1) Subject to the provision of this Act and the Ordinances Statutes, the Ordinances may provide for any matter which by this Act or the Statutes is to be or may be provided for by the Ordinances.
 - (2) Without prejudice to the generality of the provisions of sub-section (1), the Ordinances shall provide for the following matters, namely:-
 - the admission of student, the courses of study and the fees therefore, the qualification pertaining to the degrees, diplomas, certificates and other courses; the conditions for the grant of fellowships, awards and the like;
 - (b) the conduct of examinations, including the terms and conditions and appointment of examiners; and
 - (c) the management of Colleges admitted to the privileges of the University.
 - (3) The first Ordinances shall be made by Vice-Chancellor with the previous approval of the State Government and the Ordinances so made may be amended, repealed or added to at any time by the Executive Council in such manner as may be prescribed.
- The authorities of the University may make Regulations consistent with this Act the Statutes and the Ordinances for the conduct of their own business and that of the committees, if any, appointment by them not provided for by this Act, Statutes or the Ordinances, in such manner as may be prescribed.

CHAPTER - VII Annual Report and Accounts

- 30. (1) The annual report of the University shall be Annual Report prepared under the direction of the Executive Council which shall include, among other matters, the steps taken by the University towards the fulfillment of its objects.
 - (2) The annual report so prepared shall be submitted to the Chancellor on or before such date as may be prescribed.
 - (3) A copy of the annual report, prepared under sub-section (1) shall also be submitted to the State Government.
- 31. (1) The annual accounts and the balance sheet of the University shall be prepared under the direction of the Executive Council and shall, once at least every year, and at intervals of not more than fifteen months, be audited by the Directors, Local Funds Accounts, Uttar Pradesh or by such person or persons as the State Government may authorize in this behalf.
 - (2) A copy of the annual accounts and the balance sheet together with the audit report thereon shall be submitted to the State Government alongwith the observation, if any, of the Executive Council before the thirtieth of Septembers every year.
 - Government on the annual accounts shall be brought to the notice of the Executive Council and the views of the Executive Council, if any, on such observations shall be submitted to the State Government.

- 32. (1)An Officer specified in any of the clauses (b), (c), (d), (e), (f), (g) and (h) of section 9 shall be liable to surcharge for the loss, waste or misapplication of any money or property of the University, if such loss, waste or misapplication is a direct consequence of his neglect or mis-conduct.
 - (2)The procedure of surcharge and the manner of recovery of the amount involved in such loss, waste or misapplication shall be such as may be prescribed.

CHAPTER - VIII Conditions of Service of Employees

- Except as otherwise provided by or under 33. (1) this Act employee including a teacher of the University may be appointed under a written contract and such contract shall not be inconsistent with the provisions of this Act, the Statutes and the Ordinances.
 - The contract referred to in sub-section (91), (2)shall be lodged with Finance Officer of the University and a copy of which shall be furnished to the employee concerned.
- Any dispute arising out of a contract of Tribunal of 34. (1) employment referred to in section 33 between Arbitration the University and an employee or a teacher shall at the request of either party, be referred to a Tribunal of Arbitration which shall consist of one member nominated by Council, one Executive member nominated by the employee or teacher concerned and an umpire to be nominated by

the Chancellor.

- Every such reference shall be deemed to be a Act No. 26 of submission to arbitration upon the terms of 1996 this section within the meaning of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.
- The University shall constitute for the benefit Provident and of the employees and teachers such Pension funds provident or pension funds or provide such insurance schemes as it may deem fit in such manner and subject to such conditions as may be prescribed.
 - Where any provident or pension fund has been so constituted, the State Government may declare that the provisions of the Provident Funds Act, 1925 shall apply to such funds, as if it were a Government provident Fund.

- The University shall appoint such number of 40. employees including academic staff as may sanctioned by the State Government from time to time. The terms and conditions of service of the employees of the University shall be such as may be prescribed.

CHAPTER - X Miscellaneous and Transitory Provisions

If any difficulty arises in giving to the Power provisions of this Act, the State Government remove

- No order under sub-section(1) shall be made after the expiration of the period of two years from the commencement of this Act.

THE OBJECTS OF THE UNIVERSITY

The University shall endeavour education, research, training and extension to play a positive role in the development of the State, and, based on the rich heritage of the State to promote and advance the culture of the people of India and its human resources and towards this, end, it shall;

- (a) Strengthen and diversify the degree, diploma and certificate courses related to the needs of employment and necessary for building the economy of the country on the basis of its natural human resources;
- (b) Provide access to higher education for large segments of the population, and in particular, the disadvantaged groups such as those living in remote and rural areas including working people, housewives and other adults who wish to upgrade or acquire knowledge through studies in various fields;
- (c) Promote acquisition of knowledge in a rapidly developing and changing society and to continually offer opportunity for upgrading knowledge, training and skills in the context or innovations, research and discovery in all fields of human endeavours.
- (d) Provide an innovative system of University level education, flexible and open, in regard to methods and pace of learning combination of courses eligibility for enrollment age of entry, conduct of examination and operation of the programmes with a view to promote learning and encourage excellence in new fields of knowledge;
- (e) Contribute to the improvement of the educational system by providing a non formal channel complementary to the formal system and encouraging transfer of credits and exchange of teaching staff by making wide use of texts and other software

- (f) Provide education and training in the various arts, crafts and skills of the country, raising their quality and improving their availability to the people.
- (g) Provide or arranged training of teachers required for such activities or institutions;
- (h) Provide suitable post graduate courses of study and promote research;
- (i) Provide the counseling and guidance to its students; and
- (j) Promote national integration and the integrated development of the human personality through its policies and programmes.
- The University shall strive to fulfill the above objects by a diversity of means of distance and continuing education, and shall function in co operation with the existing Universities and Institutions of higher learning and make full use of the latest scientific knowledge and new educational technology to offer a high quality of education which matches contemporary needs.
